We're recruiting MPhils and DPhils from Oxford as volunteer tutors on our 8th annual Oxbridge International Summer School (OISS).

The OISS is one of the most academic of the many summer schools in Oxford. Over 8 years we've been consistently thrilled with the ability, enthusiasm and maturity of the 15-18 year old students who join us. **Tutors compare the experience very favourably to undergraduate teaching.**

We're a deliberately small programme, which students have to apply to join. We select students based on school grades, English fluency, and a short phone interview.

We're looking for post-graduate students at Oxford University who can commit to tutoring part-time on at least one of our 2-week Oxford-based programmes.

We ask our tutors to design the course they would most enjoy teaching, using our resources, reading lists, and lesson plans from previous years for inspiration.

Tutoring is an unpaid, voluntary role. For volunteering, we donate £1,000 to a charity of your choice, and use the rest of the profits to fund our [Widening Participation Programme](#).

We recognise you have plenty of other commitments and limited availability. That's why tutorials on the programme are only **90 minutes per day**, 6 days per week.
