The Gatehouse is looking to recruit a new committed and experienced volunteer Treasurer to join our Board of Trustees due to a forthcoming retirement. The Gatehouse is an award-winning Guest and volunteer led community drop-in centre in Oxford with 35 years' experience of reaching out to, and supporting, adults who are homeless, vulnerably housed, on low or no income, and/or looking for company and community. We provide practical support in reducing inequalities, isolation and disadvantage on an open access basis, and are also dedicated to supporting individuals to gain and retain housing and to reducing and addressing inequalities and barriers in health, education, employment and well-being. The Gatehouse champions the amplification of lived experience voices, opportunity and progression and in this way seeks to impact and influence service change both internally and externally.

The project was started by the Oxford city churches as a winter daytime shelter in November 1988 and quickly developed into something more. The Gatehouse's official title is Homeless People and the Oxford Churches, which reflects its client-centered vision and Christian origins, but it is an independent registered charity which does not proselytise. The Gatehouse has a board of trustees (currently 9), a full-time paid CEO and 18 staff; its annual turnover is approximately £500,000. The role of Treasurer is voluntary and not accompanied by any financial remuneration. The term of appointment is anticipated to be at least three years, entailing around five hours of time a week. Along with the other trustees the Treasurer will champion awareness of issues around homelessness in Oxford and beyond and will be a public face of the Gatehouse. An ability to foster relationships with other faith and non-faith communities in Oxford will be required.
